INFRACTION DISCOVERY REQUESTS FOR A CONTESTED HEARING
IRLJ 3.1; BNMIR 3.1

This notice is provided as a courtesy to those individuals who are not represented by legal counsel. The Office of the Prosecuting Attorney cannot and will not provide legal advice to you.

Requests for discovery for a contested hearing must be directed to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney. The Prosecuting Attorney is Rajeev Majumdar, and his mailing address is P.O. Box 1258, Blaine, WA 98230. Discovery for contested traffic infractions will be provided pursuant to the Infraction Rules for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction (IRLJ) 3.1 and BNM IR 3.1.


Your Discovery request must be in writing, must be served on the Court and the Prosecuting Attorney, and should contain the following information:

1. Your full name.
2. Your case number.
3. The City and Court in which your ticket was filed.
4. The address where discovery is to be mailed.
5. What discovery materials you are requesting.
6. The date of your request.
7. Your signature.
8. A self-addressed stamped envelope to be provided to the prosecutor for mailing.

File the original discovery request with the Court where your ticket was filed and file a copy of the discovery request with the Prosecuting Attorney by mailing it to him within the time limit plus 3 days for mailing. Your requests will **NOT** be processed unless it is served timely on the Prosecuting Attorney. Same day requests will not be processed. The prosecuting Attorney will not respond to facsimile or electronic requests without prior permission. Upon receipt of your written discovery request, the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney will mail discovery to the address you have provided. Your request must be received by the Prosecutor at least 14 days prior to your hearing.

If you have questions about the discovery procedure, they should be directed to a infraction defense attorney or you may refer to the Washington State Infraction Rules for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction and the Blaine Municipal Court Local Infraction Rules, both of which can be accessed here: http://www.courts.wa.gov/court_rules/
