

Project Name	Shoreline Master Program Update

Project Description	A non-project action to update the City of Blaine's Shoreline Master Program. This Determination is for the Periodic Update. The Shoreline Master Program updates that are part of the Comprehensive Update process were reviewed under the 12/19/14 DNS issued under City permit number SEP-7-14.
Proponent	City of Blaine – Community Development Services
Location	All shoreline areas within the corporate limits of the City of Blaine. Shoreline jurisdiction including the water areas of Drayton Harbor, Semiahmoo Bay and Dakota Creek, together with the lands underlying them, plus those lands within 200 feet of the ordinary high water mark including wetlands associated with these water bodies.
Lead Agency	City of Blaine
Determination	The lead agency has determined that this project does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. Information on the process and the project is available to the public upon request at the City of Blaine, Community Development Services office.
Comment Period	This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340 (2). The lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of issuance. Comments must be submitted by the end of the business day on June 26, 2019.
